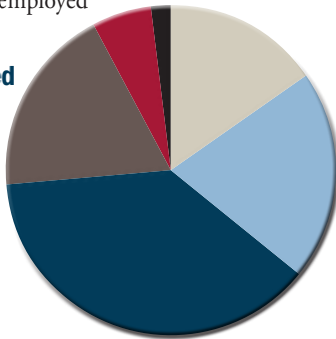
CLASS OF 2022 EMPLOYMENT OUTCOMES
